



International Spring School in Paris

„The Ancient City“

25.02.-03.03.2018

The Strategic Partnership "Ancient Cities", co-financed by the ERASMUS+ program of the European Union, organizes a summer school on the topic "The ancient city" in Paris from 25.02. until 03.03.2018. **The Summer School will give students a comprehensive overview of current research in urban archaeology.** The lecturers come from the universities in Aarhus, Bergen, Birmingham, Kiel and Paris. Aarhus is represented by the Department of History and Classical Studies and the Danish National Research Foundation under the grant DNRF119 - Centre of Excellence for Urban Network Evolutions (UrbNet).

The summer school program includes seminars, project work in international teams and a one-day visit program (among others to the Louvre). After the successful participation, the students receive a confirmation of attendance with 3 ECTS points.



A total of five students from Aarhus can participate in the summer school together with students from the universities in Kiel, Bergen, Birmingham and Paris. The costs of travel and accommodation as well as part of the catering costs are refunded by the ERASMUS + program. Students who are enrolled in the BA course Classical Archaeology at Aarhus University are eligible to participate.

Applications for participation can be submitted with a short curriculum vitae and a one-page motivation letter in digital form until 15.11.2017 to Rubina Raja (rubina.raja@cas.au.dk) and Michael Blömer (michael.bloemer@cas.au.dk). The decision on participation will be announced on 20.11.2017.
