



International Spring School in Aarhus
„e-Learning and Archaeology“
23.04.-27.04.2019

The Strategic Partnership "Ancient Cities", co-financed by the ERASMUS+ program of the European Union, organizes an international spring school on the topic "e-Learning and Archaeology" in Aarhus from April 23rd until April 26th 2019. **During the Spring School, a group of 25 students from the Aarhus, Athens, Bergen, Kiel and Paris will gain a comprehensive overview of different technical possibilities and didactic methods of e-learning, using the ancient city as an example.** The lecturers will come from the universities in Aarhus, Athens, Bergen, Kiel, Paris and Philadelphia. Aarhus is represented by the Centre for Urban Network Evolutions (Rubina Raja and Michael Blömer) and the Center for Undervisningsudvikling og Digitale Medier.



The spring school program will include seminars, project work in international teams, and a visit to Moesgaard Museum. After the successful participation, the students will receive a confirmation of attendance and 3 ECTS points.

A total of five students from AU can participate in the spring school and will meet up with students from the partner universities. Students who are enrolled in the BA as well as MA courses in Classical Archeology at the AU are eligible to participate.

Applications for participation can be submitted until December 6 to Michael Blömer (e-mail michael.bloemer@cas.au.dk). They must include a short curriculum vitae and a one-page motivation letter in digital form. The decision on participation will be announced on Dec 13. We look forward to your applications!
